Agreement on joining the PPNT Gdynia partner network
to the Coworking space lease agreement No.

concluded in Gdynia on between:

Gdynia Municipality with its registered office in Gdynia (81-382) at Al. Marszałka Piłsudskiego 52/54, NIP 5862312326, represented by Anna Borkowska - director or Anna Kawa - deputy director of the budget unit of the Pomeranian Science and Technology Park Gdynia, with its registered office in Gdynia (81-451) at Al. Zwycięstwa 96/98, based on the powers of attorney granted, hereinafter referred to as PPNT Gdynia,

/ the representative has been individualized upon placing their handwritten signature under the Agreement/

and

....., company / as part of its business activity under the name with its registered office in [], entered into the National Court Register under KRS number [] by the District Court in [] / into CEIDG, NIP: [], represented by [], referred to as the **PPNT Partner**, together referred to as the Parties.

§ 1

1. Under this Agreement, the PPNT Partner joins the PPNT Gdynia cooperation partnership network, hereinafter referred to as the Coworking Partnership.

2. The Agreement is concluded for the period until the end of the Coworking Space Lease Agreement No., with the possibility of earlier termination by mutual agreement of the Parties.

3. In the event of termination or expiration of the Agreement referred to in paragraph 2, the Agreement shall be terminated.

§ 2

1. Detailed rules of cooperation with the PPNT Partner are specified in the Instructions for PPNT Gdynia Partners available for review from the Startup Zone Team and in the Coworking Space Regulations, available on the ppnt.pl website,
2. PPNT Gdynia undertakes to carry out activities for the PPNT Partner, in accordance with the scope specified in the offer for the Coworking Partnership, which is an appendix to the Instructions for PPNT Gdynia Partners.
3. The condition for using the offer referred to in paragraph 2 of this section is that the User has a valid Package.

§ 3

The offer referred to in par. 2, item 2, constitutes de minimis aid and will be settled in accordance with the provisions in force in this respect. In the event of a change in the scope of the offer increasing the value of de minimis aid, the use of the offer will require prior submission of new documents related to the granting of de minimis aid and an assessment of whether the aid may be granted.

§ 4

In individual cases dictated by public aid regulations, the scope of the offer may be narrowed or the fee will be adjusted in accordance with the regulations applicable to granting de minimis aid.

§ 5

1. Changes to the provisions of the Agreement must be made in writing, under the penalty of nullity.
2. Regardless of the provisions of par.1, PPNT Gdynia has the right to introduce changes to the Coworking Partnership offer. Such a change does not require an annex to the Agreement. Within 14 days from the date of receipt of information about the change in the offer limiting the scope of services, the PPNT Partner may withdraw from the Agreement with effect at the end of the following month.

§ 6

1. In the matters not regulated by the Agreement, generally applicable provisions of law, including the provisions of the Civil Code, shall apply.

2. Any disputes arising from the implementation of the Agreement shall be resolved by the court competent for the seat of PPNT Gdynia, but in the first instance amicably.

§ 7

The Agreement was drawn up in two identical copies, one for each Party.
